What to Bring:

The weather is often cold, wet and rainy. Please pack accordingly.

- Sleeping bag – very important
- WARM and comfortable clothes (4 days, 3 nights)
- Jacket
- Pillow
- Towel
- Flashlight
- Rain gear (poncho, umbrella)
- Comfortable shoes for walking and hiking, possibly in dirt & mud
- Personal hygiene items (deodorant, shampoo, conditioner, etc.)
- Formal dinner attire
 - * Ladies: Please wear your favorite outfit for a formal event such as a homecoming dress, cocktail dress, or suit
 - * Gentlemen: Please wear a tie, collared shirt and nice slacks.

Transportation:

Transportation will be provided from various locations in California. AARBF staff will work with you to arrange a pick-up and drop-off location once we receive your completed application.

What Not to Bring:

- Alcohol • Non-prescription drugs
- Anything expensive or items you don't want lost or broken
